

Parking Lot Series Guidelines for the Public:

- There will be no in person ticket sales in the lobby on the night of the show and space is limited. Get your tickets early on our website (www.parkerarts.org/). You may purchase tickets on-site but you will have to do so by phone or online from a smart device.
- Guests are required to remain in their vehicles at all times with the exception of bathroom breaks.
- If you do need to get out of your car to use the restroom, you must wear a mask and maintain a distance of 6 feet between the members of your party and others.
- Our focus is on keeping you and our staff safe! All staff members will wear masks and gloves for the duration of each event.
- We are following CDC guidelines and request that you and your family do as well. We are not able to provide masks or gloves so please bring your own. Sanitizer is only available in the restroom.
- Only patrons inside ticketed vehicles are allowed to attend this event. All tickets must be purchased online in advance. No walk-up patrons or groups will be permitted.
- Attendees must follow the designated traffic plan. Attendees should enter from Mainstreet onto PACE Center Drive, then take a right on Pikes Peak Avenue. Our staff will be on site to help direct traffic.
- Please do not stop on Pikes Peak Avenue unless you are in the line for entry described above.
- We encourage carpooling ONLY with people in the patron's immediate quarantine circle.
- The number of people in a vehicle cannot exceed the manufacturer's capacity of the vehicle.
- Absolutely no sitting on, standing on, or exiting the vehicle before, after, or during the event.
- For the safety of everyone involved, no one is allowed to sit in chairs outside of their car. All attendees regardless of age must remain in their vehicle at all times. No recreational activities such as frisbee, baseball, or running are allowed.
- We are not allowing hatchbacks to be open or sitting in truck beds under the current guidelines.
- Vehicles must be parked one parking space away from each other. Our staff will guide you to the correct parking space.
- Big trucks and SUVs may be directed to the back of the lot so as not to block the screen for smaller vehicles.
- One restroom will be available for use inside the building. Those waiting to use the restroom will wait in the entry line, outside of the building, spaced at 6 feet apart, and be admitted to the building by one of our staff members one at a time. The building exit will also be monitored.

- Absolutely no standing outside of the venue or gatherings outside of the venue will be allowed and will be enforced by venue staff. The only exception is waiting in line at the entrance for the bathrooms.
- All high touch surfaces will be sanitized frequently.
- Only ticket purchasers will be given the FM frequency to listen to the show.
- All patrons must leave the premises following the performance.
- Absolutely no illegal substances will be permitted at the event or inside your vehicle and violators will be held accountable and prosecuted by state and federal law.
- No pets are allowed.
- Absolutely no illicit goods, no fireworks, weapons or guns, knives or laser pointers.
- We encourage you to bring your own food, beverage and water for now. We hope to provide concessions for events when guidelines allow.
- This is a ZERO trash event. We ask you to please take your trash with you for the protection of our employees. Please do not litter the parking lot.
- It is suggested that cars be started occasionally if you are concerned about your car battery. We have a jumper box for assistance if needed. While jumping, staff will adhere to all social distancing rules.
- Please be kind when entering and exiting. We appreciate your patience and ask you to follow our traffic directors to make this an enjoyable experience for all.
- Tickets are non-refundable. There will be no re-entry and all sales are final.
- If it is unsafe for the performance to proceed as scheduled, the event will be cancelled and the value of your ticket will automatically be converted to a donation for the Parker Arts Cultural Education and Outreach Fund. You will receive a letter acknowledging your donation within one week of the event.

Most importantly, please remember:

- If you are sick, running a fever or have been exposed to anyone with COVID-19, please stay home until you are healthy.
- If you are at risk, 65 yrs. or older, have a pre-existing immune or respiratory condition, you are urged to remain home.
