

Parking Lot Series Guidelines for the Public:

- Get your tickets early on our website (www.parkerarts.org).
- Attendees are required to wear cloth face coverings, except where doing so would compromise an individual's health. Masks are most important when patrons are moving around. Patrons may consider removing their masks when seated at a distance of six feet outdoors but must reapply their masks when moving about the event space. Masks are mandatory inside the PACE building.
- Patrons who are outside of their vehicles must wear a mask and maintain a distance of 6 feet between the members of their party and others at all times.
- Our focus is on keeping you and our staff safe! All staff members will wear masks for the duration of each event.
- Only patrons inside ticketed vehicles are allowed to attend this event. No on-foot patrons or groups will be permitted.
- The number of people in a vehicle cannot exceed the manufacturer's capacity of the vehicle.
- No recreational activities such as frisbee, baseball, or running are allowed.
- Patrons may sit in their own portable chairs directly in front of their vehicles (still within their designated parking space). Please be advised that audio feed for the event is still exclusively transmitted through FM radio and patrons sitting outside of their vehicles may wish to bring a radio for best audio reception.
- Patrons are allowed to sit in truck beds and open car hatchbacks to watch the movie as long as doing so maintains the required 6 feet of distance from fellow patrons. If you open your hatchback, please be sure that your dome lights are turned off as to not bother other patrons and that your hatch does not extend past your roof line. Bungee cords or rope to help support that request is sufficient.
- Vehicles must be parked one parking space away from each other. Our staff will guide you to the correct parking space.
- Large trucks and SUVs may be directed to the back of the lot so as not to block the screen or stage for smaller vehicles.
- Vehicles wishing to open their hatchback may be moved to the back of the lot if the open hatchback creates a visibility issue.
- All high touch surfaces will be sanitized frequently.
- Only ticket purchasers will be given the FM frequency to listen to the show.
- All patrons must leave the premises following the performance.
- Absolutely no illegal substances will be permitted at the event or inside your vehicle and violators will be held accountable and prosecuted by state and federal law.
- Absolutely no illicit goods, no fireworks, weapons or guns, knives or laser pointers.
- Patrons are allowed to bring their own food, beverage and water.
- This is a ZERO trash event. We ask you to please take your trash with you for the protection of our employees. Please do not litter the parking lot.
- We suggest that cars be started occasionally if you are concerned about your car battery. We have a jumper box for assistance if needed. While jumping, staff will adhere to all social distancing rules.
- Tickets are non-refundable. There will be no re-entry and all sales are final.

- If it is unsafe for the performance to proceed as scheduled, the event will be cancelled and the value of your ticket will automatically be converted to a donation for the Parker Arts Cultural Education and Outreach Fund. You will receive a letter acknowledging your donation within one week of the event.

Most importantly, please remember:

- If you are sick, running a fever or have been exposed to anyone with COVID-19, please stay home until you are healthy.
- If you are at risk, 65 yrs. or older, have a pre-existing immune or respiratory condition, you are urged to remain home.
