Creating Fluid Acrylic Pour Paintings Supply List for Online Class Candace French Mixed Media Artist

- 5 7 of 4 oz bottles or 2 2 oz bottles of **Fluid Acrylics** from any manufacturer in colors of your choice. **Include back and white in the 5-7 colors.** Choose colors you love and/or use in your home or work space. Or, try new colors to expand your palette. Wal-Mart, JoAnn's Fabrics, Hobby Lobby, Michael's, Guiry's and Meiningers all carry the **fluid paints**. Brands, selection and prices vary by store. **Please do not use paints that come in a tube**
- 1 Quart to one Gallon of Floetrol. Can be found in the paint department of Guiry's, Home Depot, Lowe's or any hardware store. The gallon is a better value than the quart size. Plus, if you are using larger canvases, it will ensure you will have plenty of pouring medium to use.
- 1 4 oz bottle of OGX Coconut Milk Anti-Breakage Serum. Can be found at Target,
 Walgreens or King Soopers in the hair products. Please read the label carefully as the
 OGX Mist label looks very similar to the OGX Serum label but doesn't work for creating
 effects.

These items can be found at a combination of Dollar Tree, Michaels, Hobby Lobby & Joanns.

- 1 5" by 7", 6" by 6", 8" by 8" or 10" by 10" wood panel or canvas panel.
- 3 5 canvases or canvas panels. These can be a combination of 5" by 7", 8" by 10", or 10 by 12" in size. If your creative process is a fast one, more canvases are recommended. If you want to create a diptych, bring two small canvases of the same size.
- 12 disposable small 10 ounce plastic drinking cups, the somewhat transparent ones work best.
- 12 disposable small 1 or 2 ounce plastic drinking cups or condiment cups in any color.
- Palette knife with a bend in the handle. The palette knife looks like a skinny pie server because it has a bend in the handle, but, it is smaller. It can be metal or plastic.
- 12 stir sticks can be pop-sickle, coffee or similar stir stick. Dollar Tree in the art supplies usually have a good size in stock.
- 5-6 Pairs of disposable rubber gloves.
- 1 Sharpie or marking pen in any color.
- Paper towels The less expensive the better.
- Pen or pencil and notebook or journal for taking notes.
- Table cover: Plastic tablecloth to protect the table. Dollar Tree has a good selection.
- Pouring Pans 3 5 Aluminum Full Size Steam Table Pan used for cooking. found at the
 Dollar Tree or grocery store. These pans need to be at least 2 inches larger on each side
 than your largest canvas. You will need room for your hands to hold and lift your canvas.
- Optional: Small spray bottle of rubbing alcohol for cleaning your palette knife.
- · Smock, apron or clothes you can get messy.
- Lunch and drink for lunch break.
- Computer with a camera and reliable Internet connection.
- Print out of hand outs that will be emailed to you before class.
