

**Exploring Alcohol Inks
Supply List for In Person Class
Candace French
Mixed Media Artist**

- Six or more Alcohol Inks. Choose your favorite colors and brand. Include at least one metallic Alcohol Ink.
- Ranger Ink - Tim Holtz - Alcohol Inks These come in sets of three and can be found at Michaels, Hobby Lobby, Joann Fabrics or Amazon. Note that it's much easier to read the color on the labels of the alcohol inks found at Hobby Lobby even though the same brand can be found elsewhere.
- Jacquard Pinata - These come as individual bottles and can be found at Guirys or Amazon.
- Alcohol Ink Blending Solution
- Jacquard Piñata Claro Extender
- Jacquard Piñata Clean Up Solution
- 91% Isopropyl Alcohol. Call ahead to find in the pharmacy section of Walgreens or most grocery stores. Please pour some in a small spray bottle.
- 1 small inexpensive paintbrush
- 1/4 or 1/2 inch wide Painters tape or Washi tape, one roll
- 1 pad of Yupo 5" by 7" paper. Can be found at Guiry's, Michaels and Hobby Lobby.
- 4 or more *Glossy White* Ceramic Wall Tiles about 4-in x 4-in to 4-1/4 in. x 4-1/4 in from Lowe's or Home Depot. If your creative process is fast, I suggest more than 4 tiles. The tiles come in boxes of 100. Usually you can find at least one open box to select the number of tiles you want to purchase. It is essential that you buy the *glossy* tiles as the non-glossy tiles do not give you the same creative flexibility as the glossy ones.
- Rubber gloves, at least 6 pair
- Paper towels
- Note pad and pen/pencil for taking notes
- Clothes that can get messy. The ink does not come out of clothes.
- The following supplies can be found at the Dollar Tree if you don't already have a small supply of them at home.
 - Q-tips
 - Toothpicks
 - Drinking straws, preferably with the bend in them
 - Cosmetic cotton pads
 - Plastic table cover
- \$3.00 supply fee

- Finishing spray, Krylon Spray Finish. Choose one that is heat resistant if you want to use your tiles as coasters for coffee mugs.
