- **Three or more Alcohol Inks** Choose your favorite colors and brand. Include a metallic Alcohol Ink if you like.
- **Alcohol Ink Blending Solution**
- **Jacquard Piñata Claro Extender**
- **Jacquard Piñata Clean Up Solution**
- **91% Isopropyl Alcohol** in a small spray bottle.
- 1 small inexpensive **paintbrush**
- 1/4 or 1/2 inch wide painters **tape** or Washi tape, one roll
- **Note pad** and **pen/pencil** for taking notes
- Clothes that can get messy. The ink does not come out of clothes.
- **\$3.00 supply fee** paid to instructor for tiles and Yupo paper.

- **Supplies provided by PACE**

 - Toothpicks
 - Cotton balls
 - Paper towels
 - Rubber gloves
 - Drinking straws with the bend in them
