



HISTORY COLORADO UTE KIT

Parker Arts has partnered with History Colorado to offer educators a Ute Knowledge Education Kit which combines STEM curriculum with the Colorado Department of Education’s Nuu-ciu Strong Curriculum as a resource for local educators.

The Ute Knowledge Education Kit provides a connection between Ute Traditional Knowledge and today’s STEM. The kit includes a large map of Colorado, featuring natural features and Ute homelands, as well as activities on shelter engineering, plant science, math for decoration and travel, and technology for water and clothing. Each activity set includes photos, clues, and objects as well as a hands-on challenge that allows learners to further explore each topic.

This program is a perfect bridge between history, math, and science. Written materials in the kit are in English and Spanish, and link to additional online videos and resources.
