Parker Arts presents a diverse range of hundreds of events and arts education programs and classes to over 150,000 patrons and more than 20,000 students each year, providing a significant economic stimulus for the Town of Parker and the surrounding area.

Parker Arts encompasses the many facilities and events that the Town of Parker's Cultural Department oversees.



#### Parker Arts, Culture and Events (PACE) Center

A state-of-the-art facility located on Mainstreet in Downtown Parker, offering the best of touring acts as well as performances, exhibits and education programs. The PACE Center is home to a 534-seat mainstage theater, 3,000 square foot event room, art gallery, dance studio, educational culinary kitchen, four multi-use classrooms, and Harmony Park, a unique interactive musical outdoor playground.

#### The Schoolhouse

Originally opened in 1915 as the Parker Consolidated Schoolhouse, The Schoolhouse is an important hub for community-based cultural performances, classes and exhibits. With a 200-seat theater, dance studio and classrooms, The Schoolhouse hosts plays, concerts, children's performances, recitals and classes. Space is also available for public rental. Fully renovated, The Schoolhouse combines the traditional feel of the original building with contemporary touches, creating a unique destination in Downtown Parker.

#### **Discovery Park**

Located next to Parker's library, the park and plaza on Mainstreet and Pine Drive is a unique destination. With interactive fountains in the summer, a vibrant ice trail in the winter, and performances and events throughout the year, the 1.5 acre park is a four-season community gathering place. The free Discovery Park Concert Series is held in this location each summer.



#### **Ruth Memorial Chapel**

Located next door to The Schoolhouse, this chapel was built in 1912 and is on the National Register of Historic Places. This charming and intimate venue has seating for 70 and is the perfect place for small weddings or casual meetings. At this time, there are no sponsorship opportunities at this location, but it is important to know that the chapel is a part of Parker Arts.

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
#### **Patrons**
