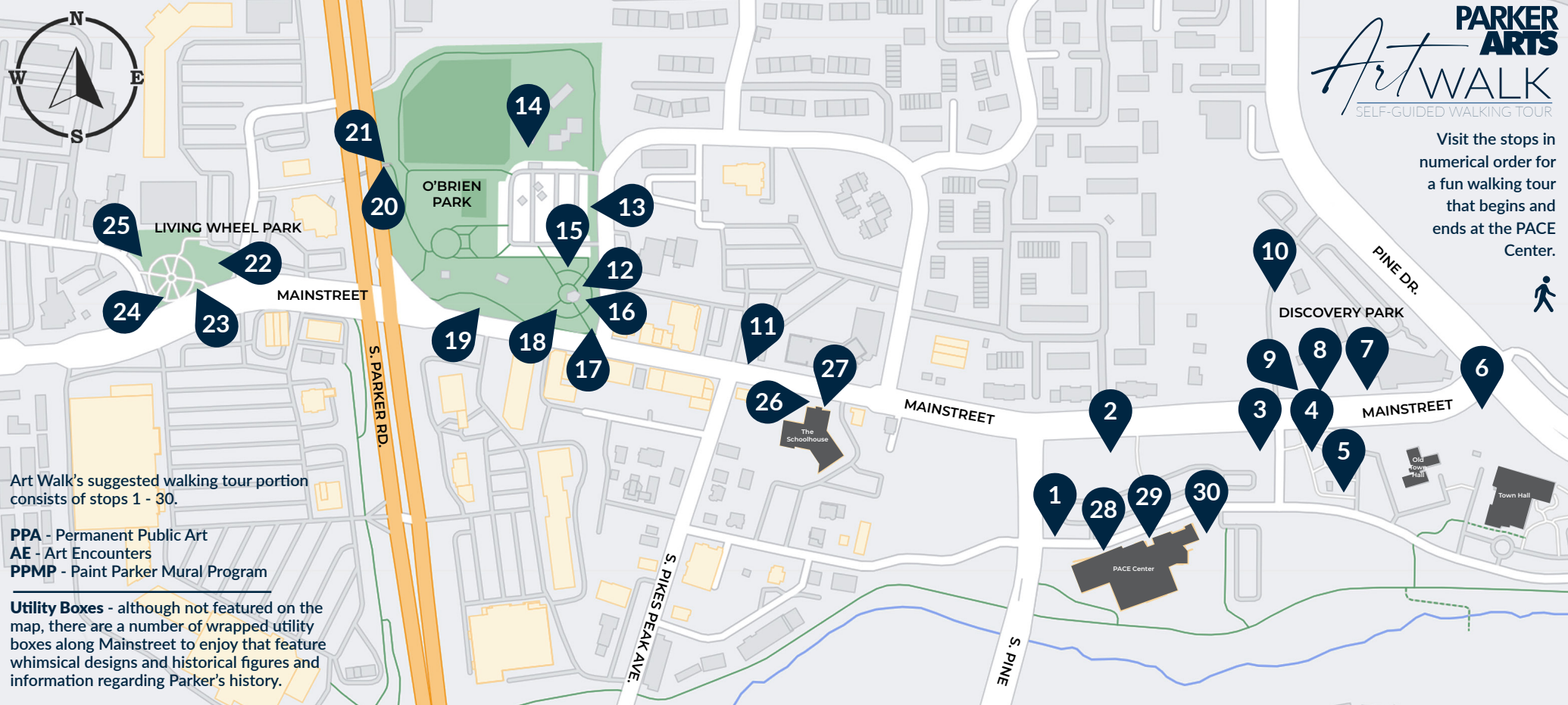


Visit the stops in numerical order for a fun walking tour that begins and ends at the PACE Center.



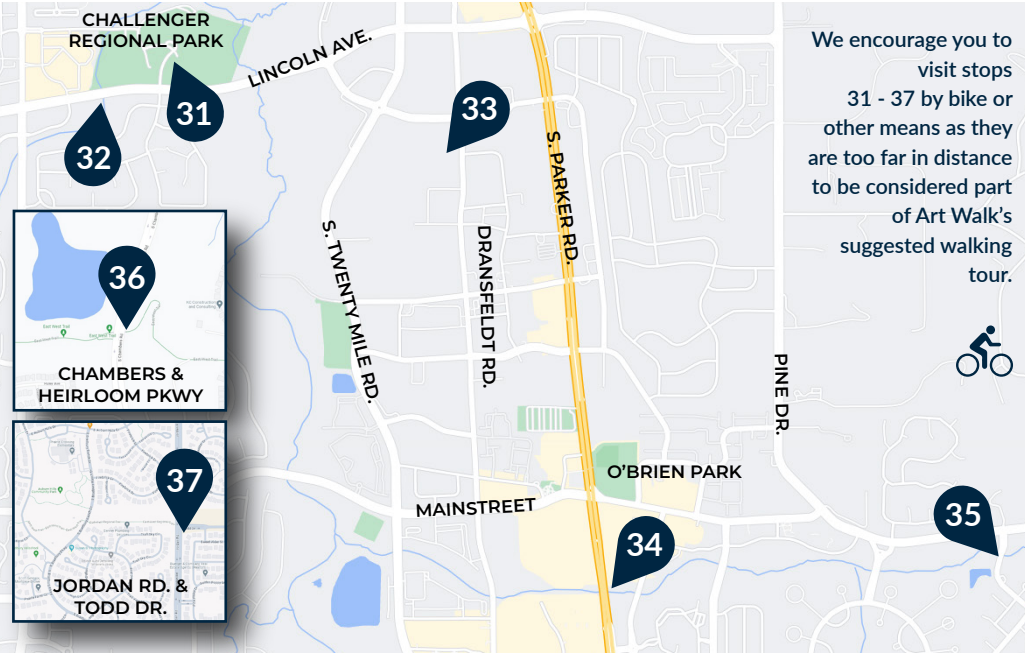
Art Walk's suggested walking tour portion consists of stops 1 - 30.

Art Encounters Rotating Art (AE):

Art Encounters is a year-long outdoor sculpture exhibit that showcases a number of sculptures in various media and styles displayed in highly visible areas of Castle Rock, Highlands Ranch, Lone Tree, Roxborough and Parker.

Permanent Public Art (PPA) Displays:

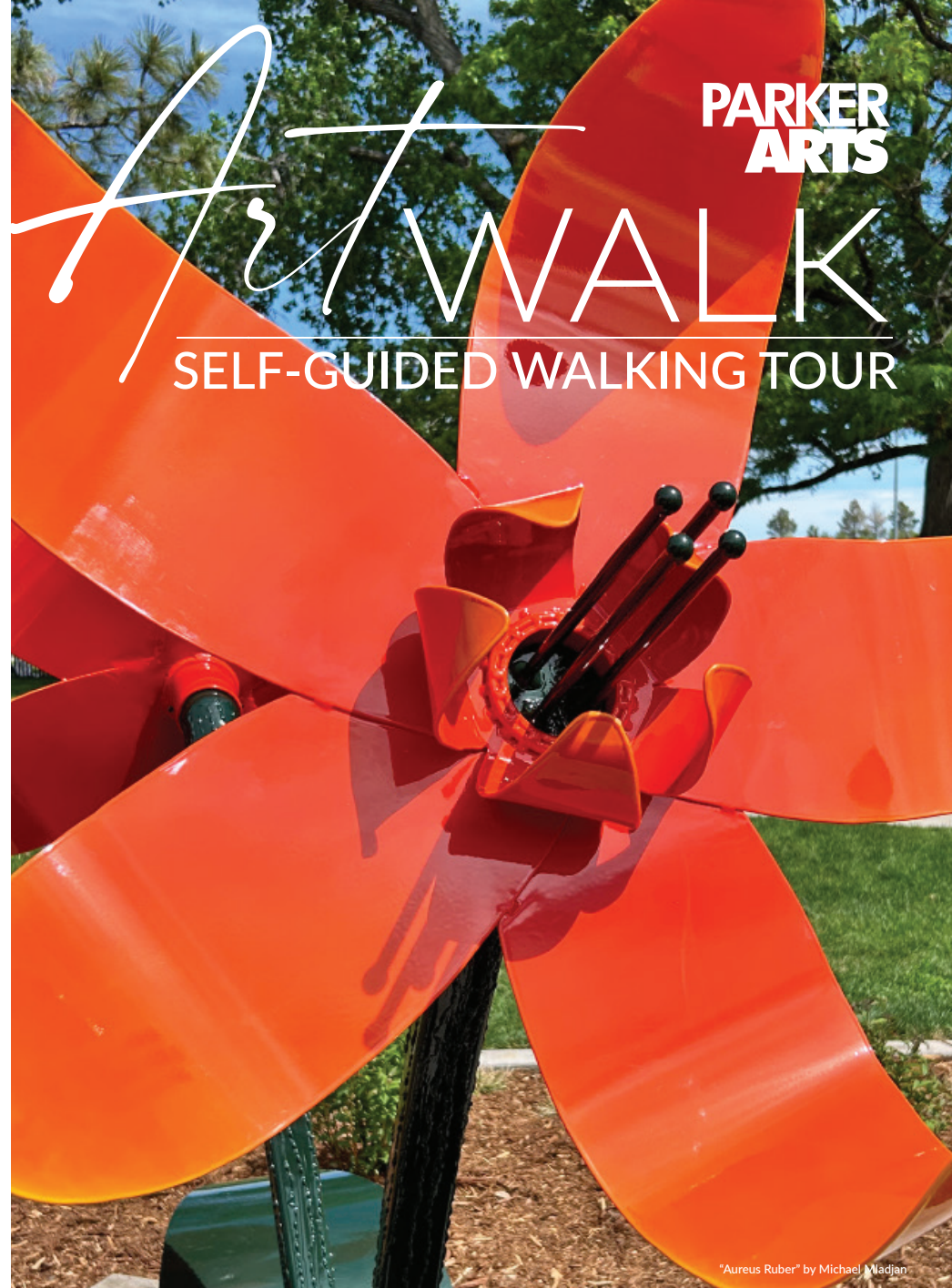
We believe that the placement of art in public places serves to enrich, stimulate and enhance the aesthetic experience in our Town. Public art also contributes to the Town's economic draw and is an ongoing education tool for the community.

Paint Parker Mural Program (PPMP):

The Paint Parker Mural Program was created for "tagging" prevention and facilitates the creation of new murals in areas where tagging has occurred along the trail and underpasses within our town. The program is a collaborative effort between the Parker Police, Parks and Recreation and Cultural Departments.
