Introduction to the Play

Characters

5. Have you ever had to stand up for yourself or a friend? How did it feel?

- **Draw a Scene!** Sketch your favorite moment from the play.
- **Act It Out!** Try playing different characters and switching roles.
- **Plant a Seed!** Grow a small plant and take care of it, just like the Girl does.
- **Write a Letter!** Imagine you are the Girl writing to the Tomato Plant Girl after the play ends. What would you say?
