 - 27 vendors signed up for this year
 - Question: does anyone have a florist connection? Possibly Bethany
- Science Committee - Robert
 - Poll given to committee members to figure out what they want to do
 - Robert will meet with Lindsey on the 21st and know more
- Strategic Planning Committee - Katie
 - Not much of an update right now
 - Last thing that really happened was the public meeting back in March. Keene presented a slideshow of preliminary data (not particularly shocking info)
 - Vision Zoom meeting at end of May with staff and then bringing vision to rest of commission. Wrapping up at end of summer and then implementation in August or later

 - Does anyone have any other ideas?
 - Suzanne: Backstage has wall of fame – maybe reprint and bring it out front
 - Katie: Special members benefit for the 15th year, 15 percent discounts
 - Christine: Could do 15 days (Annie- it’s too much)
