1. Meeting called to order by Christine at 5:30

2. Welcome/Roll Call

3. Approval of Minutes from March's PAC Meeting

Michael made the motion to approve the March minutes, Diana seconded, the motion passed unanimously

4. Commission Member Update (filling Phil's spot)

- Mark Steinhauser has agreed to fill Phil's vacancy and will be appointed as a Public Art Commissioner at an upcoming Town Council meeting. We are not required to have an Alternate, so there is no need to recruit for that position.
- The Commissioners were informed that per the Town's new Commission SOP Manual, individuals cannot serve on more than one Commission. Therefore, Diana Norton, Michael Montaya and Christine Kennedy will need to decide before the end of the year, which Commission they want to continue serving on.

5. Budget Discussion

- The group reviewed the proposed budget that was developed by Carrie and Christine.
- After some discussion, Diana made the motion to adopt the budget as recommended, Phil seconded, and the motion passed unanimously

6. Project Updates

- **Fieldhouse Climbing Wall Mural** – Michael and Mark will begin working on this project soon. Carrie will send Michael pictures of the space at the Fieldhouse, along with some sample RFP's.
- **Lemon Gulch Mural** – The mural was completed by in late March by over 175 individuals who are part of the LDS Women's Group. The final design can be viewed here:

- **Parking Garage Mural**- On March 31st, the PACE parking garage mural project officially launched. A selection panel - including Town Staff, Public Art Commissioners, downtown business owners, and representatives from the Turtle Creek and Rowley Downs neighborhoods - reviewed the project's design, timeline, and scope. They also discussed artist selection criteria and the overall selection process. The group will reconvene in April to review the draft Request for Qualifications and decide how and when to gather public input. Updates on the project will be shared regularly with Town Council.
- - **Art Encounters** – We were not able to secure the "Color Molecules" piece because the artist is from California and was not willing to ship the sculpture out without additional financial support. Therefore, we chose to

move forward with “Possibilities,” which will go in Discovery Park. The groups asked Phil to send out the price for each of the pieces that we got, so they can see what they would cost if we decided to purchase them.

- **Utility Wraps** – Diana and Christine will review the Public Art Master Plan and its priorities areas, then work to identify possibly locations throughout the Town for five new wraps in 2025. Diana also suggested that we work with the artist who is chosen to do the Parking Garage Mural and see if we
- can license their work for the wraps to the east of the garage in 2026.
- **Mural and Utility Wrap Standards and Guidelines** – Kendall has created a rough draft of the Utility Box guidelines and would like assistance from the Diana and Cindie on editing it. It’s requested that any edits are given back to Kendall by 4/23. Kendall will begin work on the Mural Standards next and will be reaching out to Michael and Cindie for help on that document.
- **Move of PACE Center Lot Sculptures** – Carrie shared the plans to move the four sculptures that currently sit on the PACE Center lot to other locations around town.

7. Other Business

- Parker Proud booth on 9/20 – Diana and Christine are willing to work at the booth if needed
- Commissioner Field Trip – Christine suggested that the group take a walking tour of murals in Downtown Denver in preparation for us doing our first mural in Parker. The group was very interested in doing this and thought a Saturday daytime would work. Christine will send out a Doodle Poll to get a date set for this.

8. Next Meeting Date/Time

The group agreed to try hold the walking tour in late May and then have our next PAC meeting in June. Christine will send out a Doodle Poll to set the next meeting date as well
