1. Roll Call

2. Approval of Minutes from November's PAC Meeting

- Cindie moved to approve, Diana seconded, and the motion passed unanimously

3. The group discussed the public art projects that are planned for 2026

- Possible mural at Newlin Gulch under Mainstreet
- Cottonwood/Parker Road Stormwater Improvement Project
- Sculptures at McCabe trail
- Public Mural Policy
 - o Research Windsor's Grant Program
- Town Hall Art
 - o Commission Sculpture/Art Outside New Town Hall
 - o Town Hall Interior Art Project with ThereSquared
- Utility Wraps
 - o PACE Parking Garage (5 possible)
 - o Other Utility Wraps

- Already have some designs from last year's call for art, we have the potential for 5 more utility boxes
- Murals
 - O'Brien Park (Keiffer's Crossing)
 - PACE Parking Garage Mural
 - Work to Begin Spring 2026
 - Plans to Capture Parking Garage Mural Process and Community Dedication
 - What is the social media narrative? What does it look like when it is finished? How to commemorate/dedicate/celebrate the completion of the piece?
 - Carrie proposes that the history committee of the cultural commission puts together something to help explain the history that the mural is showing.
 - Mango Mural
 - Have settled on a design concept. Area will be primed this week. Painting will occur when the weather allows
- Salisbury Park
 - New PROS Art Project
 - PROS might want to collaborate on another project in Salisbury Park
 - Salisbury Park Sculpture Dedication Ceremony Plans
 - Possibly being installed this summer. Timeline will be clarified once we have more information and plans for dedication can proceed then
- 2026 Art Encounters
 - The call for sculptures is live now and ends in February. Selection will occur shortly after
 - Purchase Spiral Vortex
 - The group discussed the option to purchase this existing Art Encounters sculpture to place in front of Town Hall. Michael moved to purchase the piece, Mark seconded, and the motion passed unanimously

- Sculpture Condition Assessment
 - The sculpture TimeStones is now 20 years old and is falling apart. The artist has passed and the Parks team can no longer continue to glue the pieces on.
 - We need commissioners to go to O'Brien to take pictures so that we can determine if this piece can be repaired
- Plaques
 - The only plaques left to be installed are at our mural sites. We will try to complete that project this year.
- 2025 Accomplishments
 - Diana drafted content for this topic and will share it with Carrie. We will ask the Parker Arts marketing team to share it on social media, our website, and/or wherever they see fit

4. 2026 Budget

- The budget for 2026 remains the same as 2025, and we have funds available in the Public Art Reserve Account.
- We will need to determine how the budget will be allocated once we have a better idea of all the projects we'll be taking on

5. Strategic Plan Update

- The plan has been finalized and will be adopted by Town Council on Feb. 2.
- It integrates with and supports our Public Art Master Plan
- Future Goal: Creative District Certification?
 - The group discussed whether this is something we want to pursue down the road. We agreed that it will take more thought and consideration, and we'll revisit in the future
