Minutes

- 1) Welcome/Roll Call
 - a) Start at 5:40PM
 - b) Present: Christine Kennedy, Diana Norton-Stucky, Cindie Perry, Mark Steinhauer, Hima Mangipudi, Michael Montoya
 - c) Absent: Dave Reiter (excused)
 - d) Also in attendance: Jody Walker (PROS Commission)
- 2) Approval of Minutes from April's PAC Meeting
 - a) Michael moves to approve. Cindie seconds. Unanimous approval.
- 3) 2026 Projects
 - Mural Projects
 - o Mural at Keifer's Crossing (Michael/Mark)
 - We do have concepts from a young artist who wishes to do this as part of a Girl Scout Gold Award. Michael and Mark showed us a concept and explained some of the feedback regarding perspective, dimensions, etc.
 - The artist plans to start painting the project in July once she orders the supplies needed
 - o PACE Parking Garage Mural (Michael/Mark)
 - Bimmer primed and power-washed west side yesterday. Hoping to start this week with Ratha Sok
 - Website information being compiled and edited
 - o Newlin Gulch Mural (Micheal/Mark)
 - Mark mentioned this project to PAG artists, and there was mild interest, but it didn't seem like anyone really was committed to moving forward
 - Multiple, large spaces. Estimated cost for supplies is \$20k (not including artist pay)
 - Options for fundraising, potential to do an RFP, to solicit artists, perhaps seek out emerging artists

- Carrie will talk to the Parks team about which space is the priority, and we will discuss a plan at our next meeting
- Public Art Mural Policy (Michael/Cindie)
 - We have samples. Cindie has a September goal for completing a draft
- Salisbury Park (Dave/Michael)
 - Jody shared that Tooza is still fabricating the piece for Salisbury. No detailed timeline for installation yet. Section of park where piece will be placed is still being used as an entryway for construction
 - Timeline for phase 2 artwork: Potentially place artwork at one of the other main entrances
 - The group agreed that unveiling phase 1 of the park and the new sculpture should be planned together, possibly in the fall, but more likely next year
- Town Hall Interior Art Project (Cindie/Hima/Dave) – Open House Invite
 - Friday June 26, hanging all the artwork
 - August 12 – open house
- Town Hall Exterior Sculpture (Carrie/Christine/Diana/Mark)
 - July 8 – kickoff meeting on Zoom
- Utility Wraps (Diana/Christine/Cindie)
 - PACE Parking Garage
 - Waiting on budget to figure out who pays for the 8 wraps that will go next to the parking garage
 - Other Utility Wraps
 - Next wrap location is Salisbury Park because that’s what fits in the Public Arts Master Plan
 - Season Announcement Fundraiser Results: The historic wrap concept won in the “contest” to choose the next wrap to go at Salisbury Park
- Timestones Assessment (Michael/Carrie)
 - We don’t know when the deaccession will be complete
- Cottonwood Project
 - Carrie has no updates, so this is on hold

4) Budget Update

- a) There are many projects still up in the air, so it's difficult to know how we'll utilize the rest of the 2026 funding
- b) For 2027, Carrie is putting the budget numbers together now, but the Cultural budget won't be approved by Town Council until November

5) Fundraising Research (Christine/Cindie) Diana wants to join

- a) Cindie and Christine organized a fundraiser for the Season Announcement party and earned over \$2,262 for a utility box in Salisbury Park
- b) Will add a bit more marketing support and planning to future fundraisers
- c) Maybe we take the room-naming policy and put it towards a mural fundraiser
